I'VE BEEN SWAPPING THESE TO WHITE-LIGHT LANTERNS (125W MERCURY BETA 795) IN MARKEATON PARK CARPARK (NEXT TO THE PAY-AND-DISPLAY MACHINES) DON'T BE AFRAID TO SAY SO IF YOU DON'T WANT THIS IF YOU ALREADY HAVE ONE. THE OLD GEC SOX LANTERN CAME FROM A CONCRETE COLUMN WHICH HAS JUST BEEN PULLED OUT IN MARKEATON ST. ALLOTMENTS PARKING AREA. THE OLD GEC BALLAST IS AN UNUSUAL ONE - I KNOW ITS A BIT TATTY, BUT THESE ARE QUITE RARE. THESE ARE SOME OF THE FIRST GEC BALLASTS USING IGNITORS (IT COULD BE 1972/1975 ISH) IT HAS SEPERATE CONNECTIONS FOR THE IGNITOR. THESE WERE KNOWN FOR BEING NOISY BALLASTS! I'VE DONE A WIRING DIAGRAM ON THE BACK IN CASE THE ONE ON THE BALLAST LABEL ISN'T CLEAR THERE WAS NO TIMESWITCH OR PHOTOCELL - THIS WAS SWITCHED FROM A COLUMN ON MARKEATON STREET
