I USED TO BUY THESE SAME LANTERNS (FROM ADVANCE ELECTRICAL ON SHAFTESBURY STREET) IN THE LATE 80'S, THEY CAME AS A PACK IN A BOX WITH A WALL BRACKET AND ALWAYS SIMPLEX SHADOW SHIFTER SECURITY LANTERN PACK!

INCIDENTALLY, IF EVER YOU CAN GET ANY REPLACEMENT NEW BOWLS FOR THESE I WOULD LIKE TO GET HOLD OF 4 OR 5 SPARES. TO DATE I'VE NEVER BEEN ABLE TO TRACK

THE CURIOUS ROUND LANTERN CAME FROM SOME HOUSING-DEPARTMENT COLUMNS WHICH WERE REPLACED WITH COSMO IRIDIUMS WHEN THE SURROUNDING STREET LIGHTS WERE REPLACED ON THE P.F.I.

WHEN YOU'VE GOT THE TIME TRY AND GET A PHOTO OF THE PHILIPS HGS 203 (IBELIEVE THIS IS CORRECT) ON THE TOP OF THE CCTV COLUMN ON KEBLE CLOSE. (OPPOSITE CROWN DERBY BY MERCURY VERSION. THIS IS A PROPER "FACTORY" 125W

ALSO, IN THE SAME AREA, IN ARBORETUM SQUARE ON THE CENTRAL PEDESTAL IS A NICE EXAMPLE OF ONE OF THOSE SON LANTERNS SIMILAR TO THE KINGSWOOD 35W
