THIS BOARD CAME FROM THE WARDEN-CONTROLLED SHELTERED HOUSING SCHEME AT ARTHUR-HIND CLOSE WHERE UP UNTIL RECENTLY MOST OF THE LIGHTS WERE ON PART-NIGHT, GOING OFF AT MIDNIGHT AND BACK ON ASTO 05.30 TO 06.00 UNTIL DAWN.

(INCIDENTALLY, ARTHUR HIND CLOSE STILL HAS NUMEROUS MERCURY'S, 125 W'S IN GAMMA 5'S, IN VERY GOOD CONDITION).

A FEW YEARS AGO THE SERVICE BURNED OUT IN THIS COLUMN AND THE ACTUAL WOODEN BOARD WAS REPLACED ALONGWITH THE CUTOUT & SERVICE GABLE, THOUGH THE ORIGINAL GEAR AND THE MSQP TIMESWITCH WERE RETAINED ... THE ORIGINAL BOARD WAS BURNED AT THE BOTTOM AND THE UCOLUMN SHOWED SIGNS OF BLACKENING/FIRE FROM

THAT ARE IN GOOD CONDITION, FOR CASES LIKE THIS WHERE

THE SERVICE CABLE IS A 4 mm SPLIT-CONCENTRIC THE SAME AS THE OUT-GOING GABLE ON THE BACK BOARD FROM THE STURGESS-SCHOOL FOOTPATH).

THE WHITE LUCY MCO40 GUTOUT WAS THE STANDARD SERVICE GUTOUT FOR STREET LIGHTS FOR YEARS IN DERBY UP TILL THE MID/LATE 90'S WHEN THE GREY GO FINLEY TYPE STARTED TO BE USED.

THE CONTROL GEAR IS UNUSUAL (THE BALLAST). THESE WERE THE FIRST THORN IGNITOR-BALLASTS, APPEARING-AROUND 1976. THESE BALLASTS APPEARED IN WITH-GEAR BETA 5'S UNTIL 1977. THE IGNITORS THEMSELVES HAVE NOT CHANGED.

THE VENNER MSQP TIMESWITCH IS QUITE DIFFERENT FROM THE SMALLER VENNER MODELS, HAVING A MUCH LARGER DIAL AND LONGER SWITCH-MECHANISM. THESE WERE ALSO AVAILABLE IN A WHITE PLASTIC CASE (LIKE A BIG VERSION OF THE VENERETTE CASE). UNFORTUNATELY BIG VERSION OF THE VENERETTE CASE IN THIS ONE AND THE GLASS IS MISSING FROM THE CASE IN THIS ONE AND THE DIAL-GENTRE-NUT IS A NEW, REPLACEMENT, ONE.
