

Elizabeth line services towards Heathrow → and Reading depart from Paddington National Rail platforms 11, 12 or 14 ≥


Elizabeth line services towards Abbey Wood via Central London depart from platform A

Contactless can be used across the entire Elizabeth line. »))



# Looking to the future of the Elizabeth line

The next phases of opening the Elizabeth line will integrate services from the east and west into the new central tunnels and stations bringing additional benefits to those travelling to and from the east and west. This connection brings the three railways together and enables services from Reading and Heathrow through to Abbey Wood and Shenfield.
